Women's Ministries A Ministry for Every Woman: Touch a Heart, Tell the World

This program was developed by the General Conference Women's Ministries to advance the work of sharing the gospel using the methods that Christ used.

There are three areas of focus when it comes to equipping, training, and inspiring women to serve: Nurture, Empower, Outreach.

- 1. Nurture: Reach Up To help women in the devotional time and personal growth, enabling them to be nurturers in the church and community.
- 2. Empower: Reach Across To equip women for their activities and projects for the church and community.
- 3. Outreach: Reach Out To help women use small group fellowship to reach others in their community.

Nurture: Reach Up

Growing Spiritually

Nurture ministry focuses on enriching the spiritual lives of women in the congregation and community, in order to encourage spiritual growth and healing, and to equip them as Christian disciples.

The Goals of Nurture Ministry

- To encourage each woman to develop a deep relationship with Jesus
- To enable women to grow spiritually through daily study of the Bible and Spirit of Prophecy
- To encourage each woman to have a vibrant prayer live
- To introduce women to the power of intercessory prayer
- To train women in various evangelistic methods, discipling of new members, and visitation

Empower: Reach Across

Touch a Heart

The purpose of Empowerment Ministry is to equip and empower women for activities and projects for women in the church and community. The objective is to involve women in evangelism and ministry (service) in their homes, churches, and communities. We encourage women to become God's instruments in a world that is dying for a touch of love and word of hope.

The Goals of Empowerment Ministry

- To train, equip and prepare each woman to be a witness to the power of the gospel.
- To encourage each woman to step out in faith as she witnesses.
- To motivate women to support and participate in the evangelistic programs of her church
- To encourage women to begin ministries of service to others using the gifts God has given them

Outreach: Reach Out

Homes of Hope and Healing

The Homes of Hope and healing program involved opening our homes to neighbors for fellowship and learning. In these perplexing times our homes can be places where family and friends gather in fellowship. Here friendships are formed; hope, healing, and encouragement are fostered and needs are met.

- Build strong friendships with other women
- Help lead women to Jesus by meeting their varied needs
- Make lasting friendships for Jesus
- Empower and strengthen women

NYC Women's Ministries -Assessing Needs

Assessing the needs in your church and community is an important step in your planning process. Not only will this assessment help you determine the demographics and needs in your area, but it is also an excellent opportunity to discover possible women's ministries team members, speakers, event directors, and other valuable resources.

This packet contains several sample surveys. By all means, tailor these surveys or create your own to reflect the needs and challenges in your church.

~ Principles to Remember ~

For Women's Ministries to be completely effective you need to reach out beyond your own church family and serve the community with obvious caring, offering programs, and personal services needed by women.

- Be aware of your audience. What will interest the secular mind, as well as the spiritual? What can your Women's Ministries plans do for them?
- You may have to do some brainstorming with non-church members to discover their needs before starting a program.
- Organization is important when dealing with any kind of advertising through public contact. Keep accurate records, telephone numbers, and contact names, with their positions designated.
- Dress appropriately when meeting these contact people or when manning booths, etc. For instance, if you have a booth at a fair you will probably wear causal clothing, but meeting with a television station manager would call for business attire
- Because Women's Ministries is a woman's group, if you are interviewed and questioned about the role of women versus men, make statements that show value for both genders and faster cooperation. Being for women does not mean being against men



Ministry Brainstorming

Coming up with interesting, new, exciting programs, outreach events, and in-reach nurturing can be a challenging prospect. It is daunting to sit down with a 12-month evangelism calendar and come up with meaningful events that will nurture women in the church, reach out to women in the community, and all within the confines of a small or non-existent budget!

Creating a Survey

- A good survey will tell you:
- Which ministries now active in your church are of interest to women
- What their needs are
- Who the women are
- The ways women are willing to minister to other women, and
- What their interests are

Include:

- A place for name, address, phone, email, and age group
- A box to be checked if they wish to attend anticipated/existing ministries
- A list of anticipated ministries
- An area to indicate which of the current ministries they are participating in
- Blanks to list their special skills or interests
- A box to check if they wish to help
- A place for them to list their special needs
- Something for each age, group, and for the married, single, and widowed

— NYC Women's Ministries — 8 Steps for a Dynamic Women's Ministry

The goal of any ministry is to make a significant difference in the lives of those you are trying to reach. So how do you get there? Here are eight steps to help you have a dynamic women's ministry.

- 1. **Prayer** Begin with prayer. God's word says when you seek Me with all of your heart you will find Me. Pray for direction on how to begin the ministry, the steps to take, and who would be the best to serve on your team.
- 2. **People -** When Jesus began His earthly ministry, one of the first things He did was to select His team (the disciples). Ask God to show you four or five women who are spiritually mature, have varied skills, and a desire to help women grow spiritually.
- 3. **Purpose -** Define the purpose of your ministry. The disciples were all unique and gifted in different areas, but they had a common objective to build the kingdom of God. It is essential you and your team define and understand the purpose of your ministry.
 - To help you define your purpose, identify the needs of women in your church/community, and then decide how to best meet those needs. The two greatest needs for women are to be evangelized and discipled.
 - The third most important need is to feel connected. We like to socialize, laugh, and share. Meet their needs by providing events, Bible studies or support groups where women can connect and feel encouraged in their faith.
- 4. **Plan -** Plan how to minister and reach women for Christ. Start small! Try not to over commit and make promises you cannot keep. Select areas to get your ministry established.
- 5. **Paper -** To keep everyone on target, write down your goals. If you are blessed with a detail-oriented person, have her keep notes. Realizing how important communication is, design a flyer or handout with your purpose, mission statement, activities, and programs for your women's ministry. Send information to your church website, and other media outlets like Facebook.
- 6. **Prepare -** It is important the ministry is organized and prepared. Ministering to women is a high calling and big responsibility. Excellent materials are available to assist you. Invest in workshops and books.
- 7. **Present -** Invite everyone to a kickoff event, dinner or dessert fellowship.
 - o Present your ministry team, your plans, and your purpose for this ministry.
 - Have someone on your team share a short inspirational talk on the importance and strength of women being together.
 - o Make the event exciting and upbeat. Door prizes are fun too.
 - o Provide a handout with dates, and locations of upcoming events.
 - o Collect everyone's name, phone number and email address. Even if you have to offer a door prize to get this information, it's worth it.
- 8. **Personal Touch -** Women's ministry requires a personal touch. From the kickoff event, divide collected names among your team and do follow-up calls, reminding them of upcoming events and seeking prayer requests. A personal touch can be meaningful, for both you and them.
- 9. **Prayer** is vital to the success of any ministry. Seek God with each detail and you can be confident He will complete the good work He is doing in and through you.
